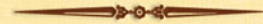

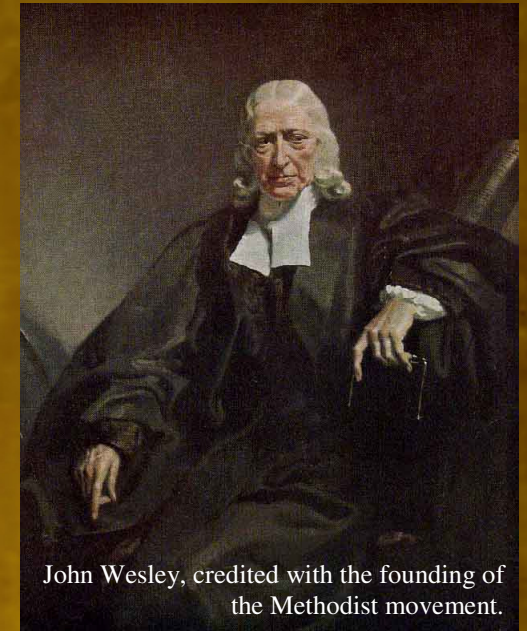
Application Deadline:
